Dear Gilpin School Community,

Governor Jared Polis signed an executive order March 18, 2020 suspending in-person learning in public and private schools across the state from March 23, 2020 to April 17, 2020. Gilpin County Schools will be closed for three weeks after Spring Break in an effort to prevent the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19).

Gilpin County School will be closed March 30 through April 16, 2020. Students and staff will return to classes on Monday, April 20, 2020, at 8 a.m.

Spring Break is March 23 through 26, 2020. [Remote Learning](#) will be paused during Spring Break and resume on Monday, March 30, at 8 a.m.

On Monday, March 30, 2020, we will provide families the opportunity to come to the school to pick up any items they may have left at the school such as supplies, medication, and technology from 8 a.m. to 12 noon.

The suspension of all after-school activities, athletics, events, and performances will remain suspended through April 18, 2020.

The COVID-19 pandemic may continue to evolve, resulting in additional adjustments for curricular and extracurricular programs for students, staff, and parents. Our objective is to keep students engaged in learning and teachers assisting students. We also need parents to help support teaching and learning at home.
