The Gilpin County School District RE-1 seeks a Special Education Paraprofessional for Gilpin County Elementary School for the 2021/2022 school year. Gilpin County Schools are on a 4-day a week schedule, Monday through Thursday. This position begins on August 10, 2021. Paid training for student support duties to be completed prior to August 10, 2021.

The Elementary Special Education Paraprofessional provides support for educational services for both general education and special needs students. Fosters a relationship with students based upon warmth, concern, mutual respect, and shared excitement in learning. Assists in the overall programming for general education and special needs students under the direction of assigned personnel.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Carries out student care directives according to the health care plan.
- Provides personal care and assistance in toileting and feeding.
- Provides mobility assistance that includes lifting and transferring the student to and from mobility equipment.
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- Provides instructional support for academic tasks under the supervision of the licensed teacher.
- Redirection of student on-task behavior and student school behavior as needed.
- Assists monitoring of student(s) during structured and unstructured times.
- Assists with related service activities such as language/communication under the supervision of the licensed specialist.
- Assists with data collection to document student progress.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:**

- Associates Degree or 48 college semester credit hours at an accredited institution of higher education or a passing score on the Work Keys assessment.
- Successful experience working with students in a classroom setting preferred.
