Dear Gilpin School Community,

An individual in Ms. Grenader's 5th grade class has displayed symptoms and has been exposed to confirmed COVID-19 positive test result. This case has been investigated by Gilpin County Public Health (GCPH). As a result of this GCPH investigation, students and staff in Ms. Grenader's 5th grade class and students in Mr. Linnehan's 5th grade technology class are to stay home from school beginning today, April 12, 2021.

- The 10 calendar day quarantine ends on April 17, 2021.
- Ms. Grenader's 5th grade class students and Mr. Linnehan's 5th grade technology class students may return to in-person learning on Monday, April 19, 2021.
- Ms. Grenader's 5th grade class students and Mr. Linnehan's 5th grade technology class students will participate in 100% remote distance learning from April 13 through April 15, 2021.

GCPH has conducted contact tracing in collaboration with school personnel. This quarantine group may include other students who live in the same household or had contact with the COVID-19 positive individual. All parents who have a child in this quarantine group have been notified. There are no other grade, class, or cohort groups beyond Ms. Grenader's 5th grade class students and Mr. Linnehan's 5th grade technology class students known at this time who have been identified and who will need to be quarantined related to this positive case.

All other PS-grade 12 students and staff are **not** subject to a school quarantine and may continue to attend in-person learning.

All students and staff should regularly monitor for symptoms and if symptoms consistent with COVID-19 present:

- Contact your family medical provider.
- Notify Connie Oliver in the School Health Office, coliver@gilpin.k12.co.us or 303-582-3444, ex, 4131.
- COVID-19 testing is recommended. GCPH provides free testing on Thursday from 10am to 2 pm. Register at <https://www.primarybio.com/l/cdphe>
- Notify Connie Oliver with the test result, positive or negative.
- Stay at home and away from the school and avoid other activities around other people outside of the household.
